We are looking forward to welcoming the children back to school for the start of the Autumn Term on **Wednesday 3rd September**.

APlease remember that school starts at **8:40 am** for Foundation 2 to Year 6 children. The gates to the the playgrounds for Year 1 and 2, and for Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be opened at **8:35am** and will be the locked at **8:45am**.

Children should be dropped off in the playground outside their classrooms, and line up under the canopy with their class teachers. For health and safety reasons, parents/carers should remain on the canopy area.

School Uniform

Our school uniform makes our children look smart and ready to learn as a member of our school community:

- Plain (or with Maybury logo) white or red polo shirt
- Grey or black trousers or skirt
- Plain (or with Maybury logo) red sweatshirt or cardigan

★Polo shirts, sweatshirts and cardigans with the Maybury logo on are available from the school ★office. Red fleeces with the Maybury logo on are also available to purchase.

PE Kit

♣PE lessons take place each week. We have decided to keep the practice of children wearing their ♣PE kits to school on PE days. However, for us to keep this practice in place, children **must** come ★to school in **school PE kit.** You will be informed during the first week in September of your child's ★PE days.

For PE, your child will need:

- A plain (or school logo) red or white polo shirt
- A pair of plain red or black shorts
- A pair of plain black jogging bottoms
- · A pair of trainers

Children have the rest of their lessons in their PE kits during the day, so it is important that they are dressed appropriately for school. The majority of our children are coming to school in the correct kit and we thank you for this. However, we do still have a number of children who are coming to school in inappropriate kit for school (e.g. football kit, branded, coloured or inappropriate colothing).


