- Mathematics Reasoning

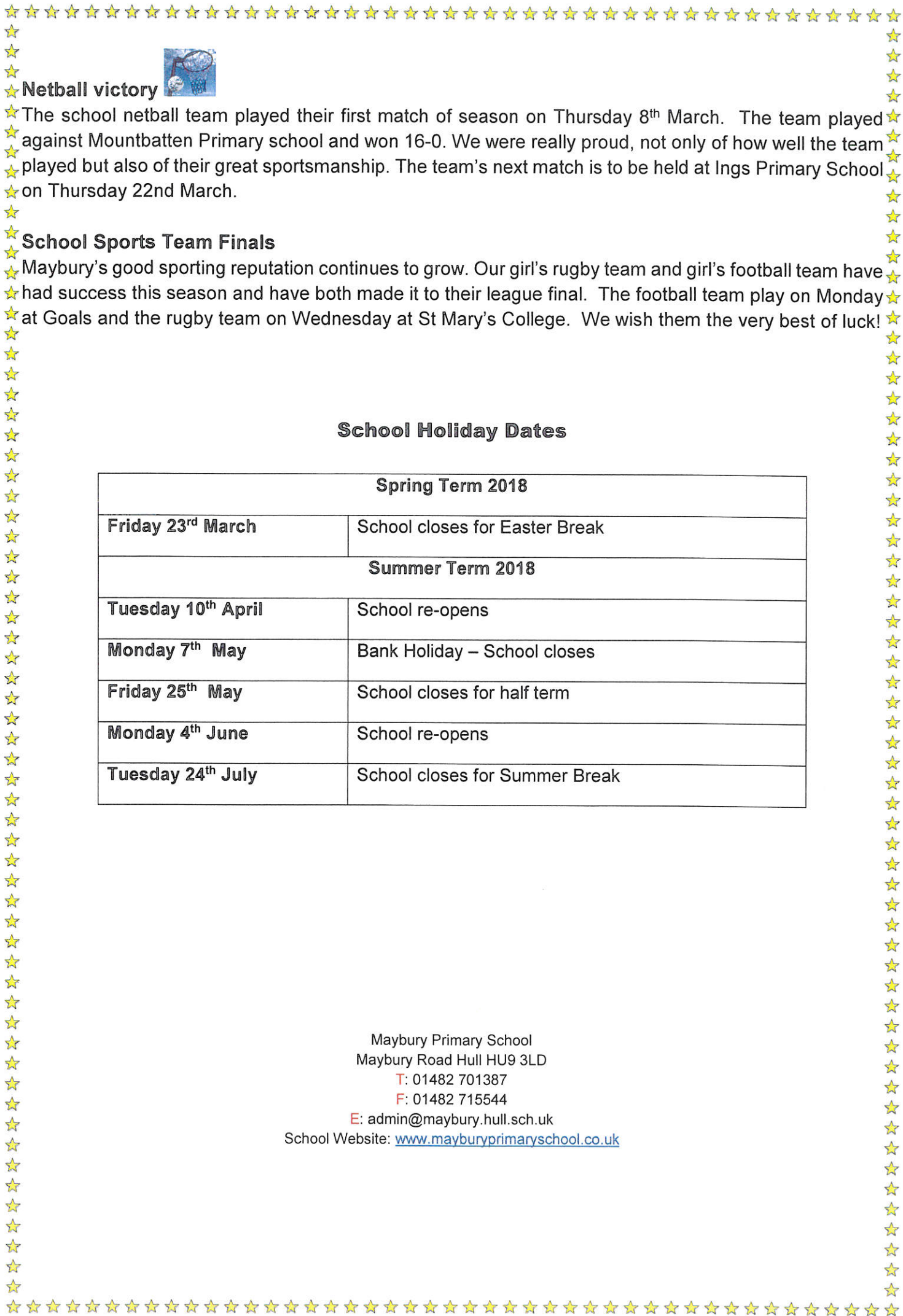
